

POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN RURAL MEDICINE CALL FOR APPLICATIONS 2024

The goal of the programme is to enable medical doctors and qualifying clinical associates the capacity and confidence to **equip themselves to practice with confidence in rural environments**. The programme is offered via flexible hybrid mode, which combines both online and in-person contact blocks for working professionals to plan their study schedules.

The postgraduate diploma is structured over an 18-month period and consists of 4 modules.

Module 1: Clinical Skills for District Hospitals

Module 2: Major Infectious Disease Challenges

Module 3: Delivering Healthcare in Rural Communities

Module 4: Clinical Governance in District Health Services

Minimum admission requirements:

MBChB/equivalent degree with at least 2 years practical experience
or BCMP/equivalent degree with at least 5 years practical experience.
