

# Postgraduate Diploma in Infectious Diseases

- **challenge participants with real case studies** throughout the programme to stimulate critical thinking and promote evidence-based decision-making.
- **enable medical doctors to work autonomously** in remote rural environments, by focussing on symptom-based problem solving in resource limited scenarios

The postgraduate diploma is structured over a 2-year period and is valued at 120 credits.

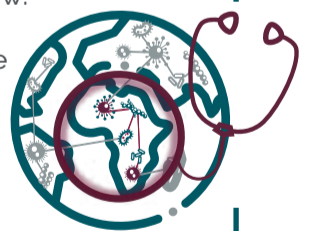
It consists of 5 modules:

- Module 2 - **Paediatric infectious diseases**
- Module 3 - **HIV and TB**
- Module 4 - **Surgical infections**
- Module 5 - **Community health for infectious diseases**

Applicants must provide the following for review:

- Proof of MBChB or equivalent medical degree
- An up-to-date CV
- A personal motivation letter form
- Confirmation of adequate clinical cases in own workplace to support the practical component of this programme.
